- Demonstrate the ability to make effective use of grant funds
- Identify financial capability and accountability via references from previous projects
- Identify opportunities for AusNet Services to promote the Energising Your Community fund

***Please note: Applications won't be considered for individuals, travel projects, political parties, projects which don't benefit the community or are discriminatory against minor groups, projects that don't foster the community's best interest nor projects that are hazardous to the community and environment.***
